SOFT SUMMER RAIN

A sizeable filly we like a lot. You can put a line through her three runs on the flat to date as they were on unsuitable ground and she has been very immature. Made some good late headway on her latest run at Southwell, where she hated the kick back but appreciated the give in the surface. She has a very workable mark of 57 and is much better than her form to date. She will next be seen over a longer trip on a softer surface. Another who will be going juvenile hurdling in the autumn and is likely to start in the fillies only hurdle at Aintree in the first week of December.

Trainers Comments: By Champs Elysees. A very large filly who is related to a couple of horses who cost a few quid. We like her a lot, she produced her best form to date at Southwell so it is clear she is going to want a bit of cut in the ground. She is quite effeminate in her approach to life, she doesn't want bullying or bustling along. But once she is in a race she knows how to put her head down and try. This filly will be working towards a hurdle race and I think Mr Robinson has one in mind, a fillies only juvenile hurdle at Aintree in December. **(David Easterby)**
